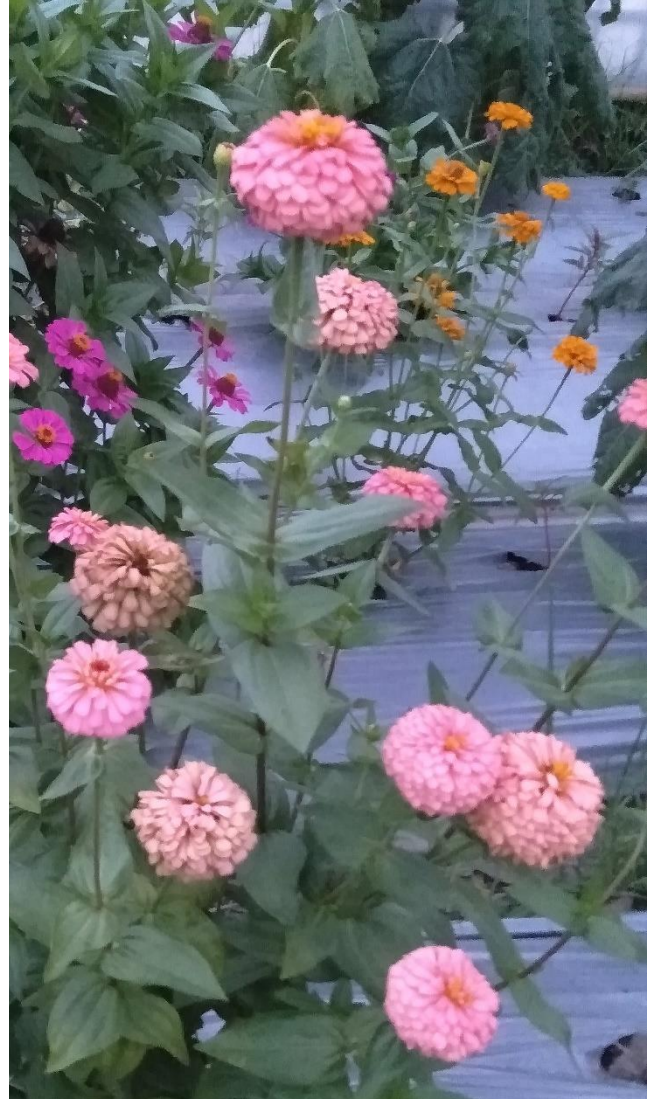

General Situation

The year 2021 is still dominated with the pandemic problem, where the impacted people is significantly increased though the government implements strict regulation and strategy to combat the virus. The lockdown is done in some cities with high cases, the school are still done in long distance (by online – zoom and google meet), the public facilities, tourism places are closed except the public service like petroleum station, market. The meetings are not allowed to involve many people, like church prayer, mosque and everyone must do health protocol.

In the aspect of learning process, it must continue to be carried out even in the covid-19 pandemic situation. The covid-19 pandemic has changed the order of the educational process, which was originally face-to-face at school, to face-to-face virtual. The online learning process requires educators to create appropriate and fun learning models and methods. However it affects students and parents in terms of economy and psychology.

The effort of the government to combat the virus, vaccination has been started to be given. The first person who is vaccinated is President Joko Widodo, held in January 13, 2021. In the beginning the people are bit worried of the effect the vaccine, but due to the building awareness campaign, the people are encouraged to have vaccine. First batch vaccine is prioritized for aged people, and continue for productive-age and children.

Even though the government has given vaccine to the community but it is not evenly done in short time, the cases increases in the mid of 2021. There was a big wave of people infected the virus, even the government gives policy to lockdown Java and Bali. Indeed, it was very bad situation, many people are died because the hospital can not accommodate the patients, lack of oxygen, even everyday there is death news in our neighborhood. Indonesian community has close relation culture, for example, when there is a family member treated in the hospital, she/he is always accompanied by several family members, or visited by many friends/neighbours. But, during the pandemic, a patient treated in the hospital is not allowed to be accompanied. This situation makes her/him get mentally down and get, anxiety, I think one cause factor of the death is also mental problem. Besides, the mental problem and depression also caused by social limitation, long time to stay at home, lost the job. According to Merdeka.com, dated 11 October 2021, there are 12 million people with mental problem (15 – 50 years old) we have during the pandemic time (increasing 6,5%).

The impact of the pandemic makes the situation of the community is getting worst. People are lost the job, especially those who are working in the factories, the business of export – import are not running well, those who works in the malls, furniture the do not work everyday to avoid the crowd, so they only receive 50% of the salary. People cannot do activities freely, so the business process is not running well.

The government continues to build awareness of the community to have vaccine and provide 1st doze, 2nd doze and 3rd one, even now in the beginning of 2022 the 3rd vaccine (booster – as complementary) has been given to the community. Until April 19, the target vaccinated people is 208.265.720, it is only 198.351.438 that have vaccine first doze, the number of people are vaccinated by second doze is 163.036.814 and the booster : 31.860.639 (data from health minister).

The foster children cannot avoid this situation, fortunately there is no one suffered from the virus, but some family members are suffered, so they must have self-isolation, however no effect that brings to the death.

A. Update of the Foster children

In 2021 we supported 13 children, consisting of 2 university students, 4 senior high school students, 5 junior high school students, 2 primary school students and support 2 clients for emergency cases.

In 2021 there is 1 child can finish study from university, she is Irene Intan Permata Sari Cahyono, graduated from Inteos Theological university. At present time, the fresh graduate

like Erene is not easy to find a job as government teacher, she has to apply with the teaching experience. Usually strata 1 graduate is usually teaching primary school. Eirene is lucky girl, after the death of religion teacher in one of Senior High School at Solo, because a kind help of a friend Erene can be accepted to teach at that school, whereas teaching at senior high school needs more education and experience. Even the status is still contract teacher, but it is good opportunity, she can have more experience to fulfill requirements to apply to be civil servant.

Unsuccess Story

Ririn, a very long time she is supported by SPF, even when his father died and she was still the 1st grade of primary school. She is good student, even she can continue study in the university. Suddenly, the mother was suffered from cancer, she has to be operated, and must have chemotherapy regularly. Her two sister and bother do not care of the mother, so she is the only child in the family who care of her mother. This makes her study is disturbed, she was often absent from lecture, as the mother can do nothing alone. She planned to drop out from university, but she was advised to take time off from lecture, when the mother get better back, she can continue the lecture. She should manage time well, to communicate to the teachers about this situation. It seemed she was frustrated, as she has to be responsible to the mother alone, and one day she told surprisingly that she would not continue studying, as she would focus to the mother, and find a job (whatever profession) to support the family.

B. Update of supporting emergency case

Emergency case in 2021 assisting bu Setiyarsih, support the regular payment of health insurance. Her condition is included the criteria of poor, as she is living alone and not working, so we will try to lobby to the government cover her health insurance.

Other emergency support went to Ana, she is a mother with 2 children, she is a housewife and the husband is working as labour. Her family is not covered by the government for their health insurance. For one year she did not pay health insurance for family, as she prioritizes to fulfill the food for the family than for health insurance. One day when she got sick and should be treated in the hospital, she needs lots money, so she was advised to pay the pending payment of the insurance to get free treatment from the government hospital.
