He is a younger brother of Paulina, student of junior high school, the same problem of economy after the death of his mother, so he needs support for the study.





Dean Lenonel Gunawan

Leonel Gunawan, he is in the kindergarten school. There are 3 children in the family. The father was formerly had warung bakso in Semarang, due to covid hit, the warung was not running. The father is looking for a job, while her mother is working voluntary in a church, which the salary is 50% from basic regional income.

Muhamad Akbar Junior

He is a younger brother of Fikri that was supported formerly (has graduated from Technician school), and working in automotive engine. So, he is substituted by her younger brother. Muhamad is in the first class of primary school. Her father is a farm labor, and her mother is housewife.

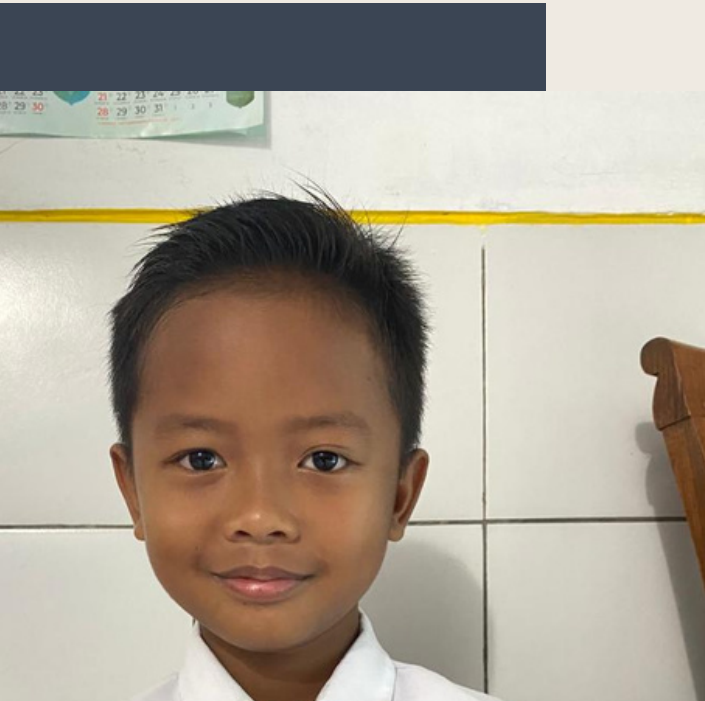


Sofyana

Berliando is a student of primary school. His father is a pastor with few congregation members. He does not have regular income, but he is commitment to serve the congregation. He needs support for his children

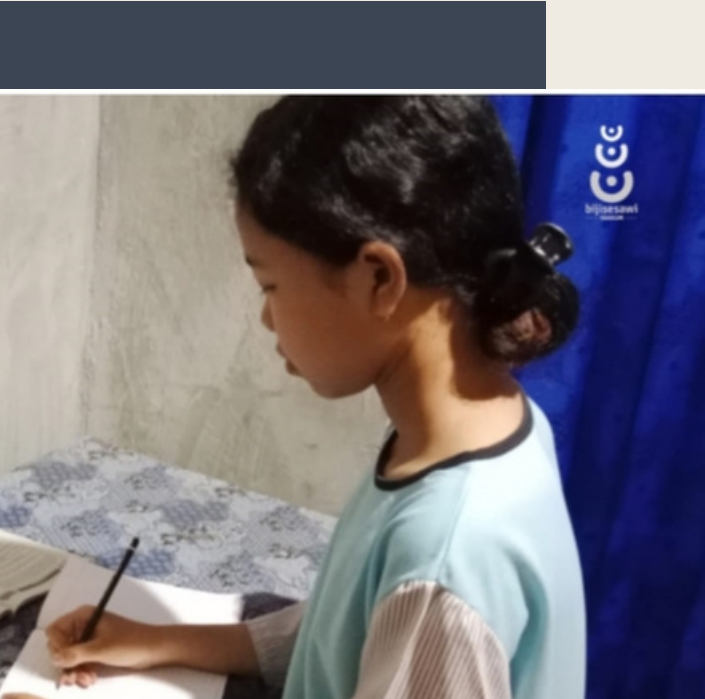
Calista Yotia Yesa

She is studying in the senior high school. Since 2 years ago his father (pastor) has been sick (stroke), he could not do activities, due to the condition, he could not make an early resign, thus he does not have income anymore. While he needs to have medication and finance the two children. The wife is an impermanent teacher of primary school with low income.

Emergency SUPPORT



SPF support 11 people with emergency problem, one of them is a communal (children with HIV/Aids). The individual cases mostly supported is education problem (cannot pay tuition at the end of graduation), health problem and economy improvement as the impact of Covid-19

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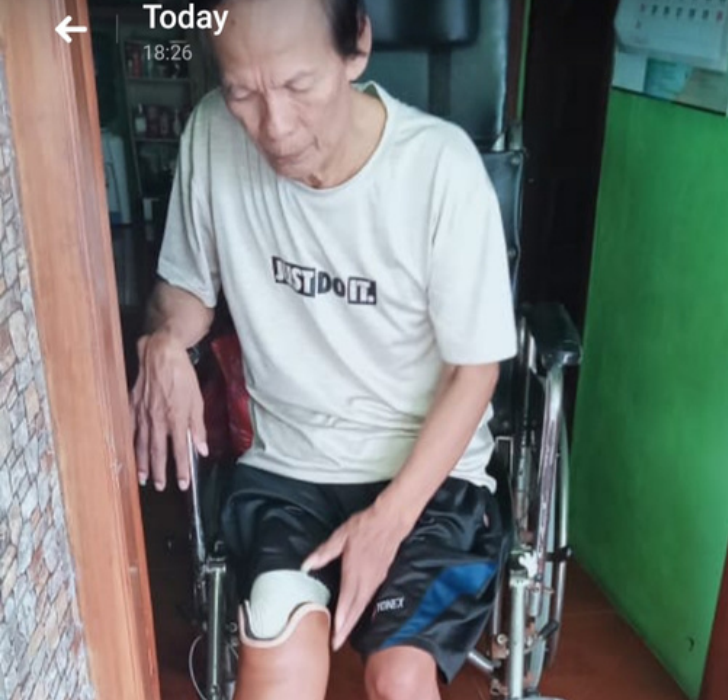

Sri Mulyani

She is a house wife that has been resigned from working at factory due to bankrupt. She was living with 2 children and has been divorce due to domestic violence. She was not aware that she had high tension, she also had not health insurance. One day she felt down and unconsciousness. She had to be treated for several days at the hospital. The money collected from her big family was not enough, so SPF gave contribution.





Sarno

He used to work in Jakarta as a brick layer. When he worked to build stories building, he fell down, and the right leg was amputated. Then he was back to village. He cannot work anymore as he cannot walk with one leg. SPF support to make artificial leg, now he can walk and do activities.



Sastro Panut

She has been suffered from cancer in her neck. She has been operated two times, and needs a regular chemotherapy, and she also try to have an alternative medicine. SPF support for transport during chemotherapy and bought herbal medicine



Endang Yuni Supadmi

She is a house hold. Her husband used to work in factory, but since covid-19 hit, the factory did not operate anymore. To survive the life, she and husband wanted to have small business at home. She needs capital to start business. N SP Support and now she is selling cilembu (a kind of sweet cassia), the process by oven.

Jose Adrian

He is a younger brother of Eirene (the SPF children). Jose was studying at vocational senior school, at the end of academic year (towards graduation) he still has tuition fee that was not paid in several months. SPF support for this need. Now he has passed school and working at a restaurant in Solo.



Putri Adisty

She is a senior high school student at Jogja. She is from a low economy family, she needs to pay lesson books, due to the condition, SPF give support to pay the lesson books.



Mutia

She is a student of theology institute. She was blind since she was born, but the condition does not discourage her to face the life. Even she has talent to sing very well. She gets scholarship from university. SPF supports her new hand stick, as the old one is broken.





Kesia (Awang Mujianto)

Two last year her house was relocated by the government , the compensation fund is not much, and her family build a small house, but not completely finished, especially the roof is often leak when rain season. SPF support for repairing roof.



Laurensius Abed Narsetya

He was studing at machine technology institute. He could not pay the last tuition fee since the father suffered from lung and does not work anymore, and the mother has been retired from a teacher. Now he has graduated and working in Jakarta.



Lentera Children
