# INTRODUCTION

It has been 23 years the children fund (Suzanne Pothof Fund - SPF) was established. It was initiated by Suzanne Pothof in which she concerned to the condition of the children in Indonesia. Once, in 1995 she had a research in Indonesia for her study and then continue working with Christian Foundation for Public Health (YAKKUM) that was recommended by UCN. During this time she was not only dealing with the nurses at YAKKUM's hospitals how develop the nursing system, but she also visited and met people in the villages. Starting from her experience meeting with the situation of unlucky people, she initiated to do a small project for funding the students. It was started in 2021 with 5 children (ex-foster children of Kindernothilfe - Germany that has stopped funding.

From 5 children, the project was growing, until 2023 it has supported about 52 children (regular financial support for students) and support for emergency cases : 40 people / cases.

## Project Goal and Target

### **Goal :**

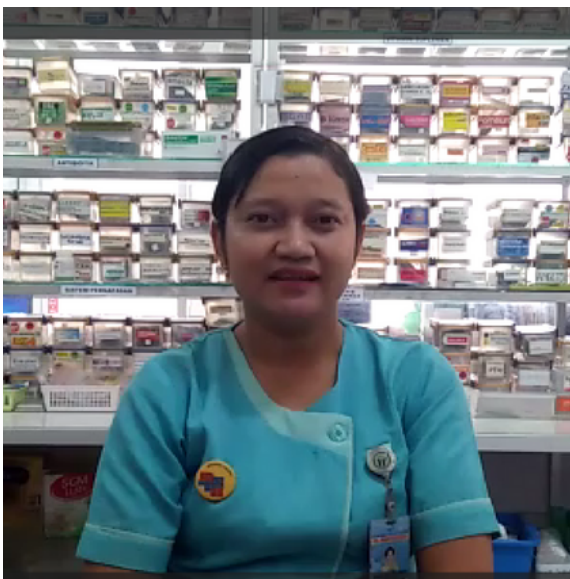
The project aims at supporting the children education and emergency cases in order they have a better life.

- Low income family
- Regardless race, religion and culture and area (since it can be reached and there is key person to monitor)
- The emergency cases is mostly prioritised for health problems and education

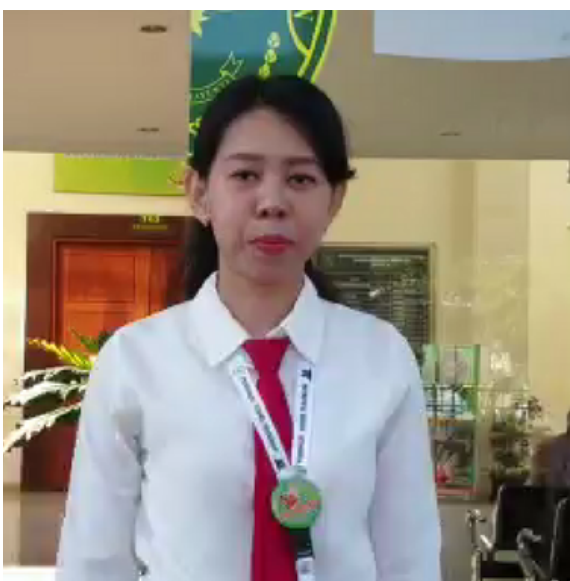
# SUCCESS STORY

The following is the success story of the children have been supported that can be monitored. Indeed, we note one child dropped out from school because she was the only child in the family, her father has died, and she had to care of her mother that is suffered from cancer.



**Septi Sri Wardani**

She was supported by SPF from junior high school 2021 until she graduated from pharmacy school. Her father died when she was still primary school, the mother is a house wife. The situation motivated her to study hard, then she can finished school well, and get a job at the hospital. Now she is working at panti Waluyo Hospital Solo (pharmacy department). She already had 2 children.



**Maria Anugrah Fajar Nugraini**

She graduated from university (law faculty ) in 2010. The unlucky background of the family made her rise up, after her mother was sick and laid down in the bed for almost 20 years.. After graduated from university she worked as legal staf at the hospital while she was learning civil and criminal law as she has a dream to be a judge. Finally her dream comes true, now he is a judge at a government court office in Kalimantan

## **Fani**

Her father died since she was in the kindergarten, and her mother got married again, so she lived with her grand parent. She was supported by SPF since 1st grade of primary school. After she graduated from Senior High School she preferred to work. Now she is working in a garment company.



## **Titus Junior**

He grows up from low income family. He only lives with her mother which is working as a factory labour. He was supported by SPF from primary school, and now he becomes a teacher at primary school



# SUCCESS STORY



## **Irene**

Since 5th class of primary school her mother died, followed by her older sister due to an illness. Several times she was shocked and no spirit to study. While her father as a pastor have low income, as he serves small congregation. The income is not sufficient to finance his children's study. SPF supported Irene from primary school until finishing university in 2022, and now she becomes a teacher at Senior High School.



## **Endang Yuni Supadmi**

Since Covid-19, there were many factories in Indonesia could not run anymore, many workers also stopped working. Endang's husband was also the one impacted that situation, he stopped working from factory. SPF gave capital to have small business at home. She cooks food, like cassava, fried onion and vegetable to survive the family life.

He was graduated from junior high school, he wanted to continue the senior high school, but the mother was not able to pay the tuition fee, as she is only housewife, and the husband was left the family for 2 years, the reason was to work in the city, up to now he does not come home and cannot be contacted anymore.



**NATALIA REXY**

Natalia, is a new child, she was just supported bu SPF in July 2023, in the 5th grade of primary school. She has same problem with Albert, his father left the family, and does not come to the family again. Her mother is only working as domestic labour with low income. While she has 1 younger brother that needs school fund.



**CARISA**

She is from low income family. Her mother is 30 years old, with 4 children. The father died 3 years ago. To fulfill the daily needs, she is selling foods, walking around the village. The income is not enough to pay school fee. Carrisa wants to study at junior high school and need to pay tuition fee.



## FUTURE PLANNING

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It is a sadness for us, all the children and families, Suzanne has left us forever. We are so sorry for her loss, certainly we are going to miss her. Our deepest sympathies to Pothof family.

I have communicated to the parents of the children that the project will no longer anymore. The families and children could understand the situation, and they are very thankful that SPF has decreased their burden relates to education of their children. They thankful to Suzanne and Pothof family and also Mirjam.

Due to there is still remains of money, we prioritised to finance the students that study at university Aldito, Sheren, Verlisa, Muhamad Junior and Natalia Remy.

1. Aldito and Sheren, they are coming from low economy, they really depend on SPF, if not they might stop studying as the cost is high enough. I have contacted to the university to know the amount needed until they finish study.

a. Aldito : Semester 2 - 8 and cost for thesis : Rp 14.790.000

b. Sheren : Semester 2 - 8 and cost for thesis : Rp 18.760.000

This will be paid to the university directly, every semester

2. The other remains for Muhamad Junior, Natalia, and Verlisa The economy is not good enough at this time. Muhammad Junior, her mother is suffering from stroke, Natalia - the mother has no permanent job, Verlisa - her father is stop working as the company is bankrupt - he is still looking for job.

a. Muhamad Junior : Rp 1.800.000

b. Natalia : Rp 1.800.000

c. Verlisa : Rp 6.000.000
